## Videographer Responsibilities:

This is a position with lots of room for creativity in producing content that features ARC dogs in a way that is dynamic and engaging. The footage created will be used for our website, social media, and other channels as the need arises. Equipment will be provided by the ARC.

Schedule: Tuesday and/or Wednesday between 10:15 a.m. – 12:15 p.m. or 1:00 p.m. – 3:00 p.m. Minimum of 2 hours per week plus potential "as needed" occasions (example: offsite events).

Skills and Qualifications:

- While we welcome everyone, experience in photography/videography is a plus.
- Comfortable working in close proximity to dogs, including the sick or injured.
- A basic knowledge of dog behavior with an ability to read a dog's body language, or a willingness to learn these skills.
- Collaboration with others in gathering and/or creating content.
- Ability to use a camera, smart phone, computer or other applications necessary to capture and upload videos.
- Will require sitting, standing, and bending
